H1N1 Flu Vaccine Clinics

In order to respond to the high demand for the H1N1 vaccine, the Brazos County Health Department will be offering special vaccine clinics. The vaccine will be administered for free on Thursday, December 3 and Friday, December 4, 2009. Numbers will be distributed beginning at 8 am on each day. To assist with clinic flow, a return time for vaccine administration will be given with the numbers.

These immunization clinics will be held at the Brazos County Health Department. Anyone 6 months old to 65 years of age is eligible to receive the vaccine.

The health department continues to encourage those individuals included in the high risk priority groups to get vaccinated.

Healthcare providers in Brazos County have begun to receive the H1N1 vaccine, as well. The public is encouraged to contact their primary healthcare provider to determine availability.

H1N1 vaccine is becoming more readily available, so H1N1 flu vaccine clinics will continue to be scheduled on a regular basis.
